David's Sacrifice

1 Chronicles 21:14-30

Lesson Aim: To show how David humbled himself before God, because of his sin.

Key Verse: King David replied to Araunah, "No, I insist on paying the full price. I will not take for the Lord what is yours, or sacrifice a burnt offering that costs me nothing. – 1 Chronicles 21:24

Lesson Concepts:

- 1. When we sin against God, it affects others as well as ourselves (vv. 14,15a).
- 2. God is merciful to us, even when we sin against Him (v.15b).
- 3. Sometimes it may be necessary to hold a public display of repentance and mourning (v.16).
- 4. It is fitting to accept responsibility and intercede for others (v. 17).
- 5. When the Lord instructs us, we are to obey. (vv.18,19).
- 6. We should respect our leaders and be willing to help them (vv.21,23).
- 7. Giving to God what cost us nothing does not demonstrate true commitment or worship (vv. 24,25).
- 8. God is pleased when our worship is genuine (vv. 26,28).
- 9. Sin causes us to fear God's righteous judgment; accepting Christ frees us from fear (vv. 29,30). **Note:1 John 4:13-18**
