

The Servant's Suffering Isaiah 53:1-7

Aim: To understand the depth of Jesus's suffering and the extent of His love for humanity.

Key Verse: We all, like sheep, have gone astray, each of us has turned to our own way; and the Lord has laid on him the iniquity of us all. ~ Isaiah 53:6

CONCEPTS

- 1. Jesus' sacrifice and power is sometimes unrecognized, forsaken and rejected. (Vv.1-2)
- 2. Christ bore God's full wrath, anger, punishment, and judgment for our sins. (Vv. 3-4)
- 3. We have been reconciled and freed from sin through faith in Jesus Christ. (Vv. 5-6)
- 4. Believers should meet injustice with grace, patience, and trust in God's plan and wisdom. (v.7)
