Saul of Tarsus, the unlikely Apostle

Acts 22:3-15

Lesson Aim: To use our life story and experience with the Lord as a witnessing tool.

Key Verse: “Then [Ananias] said: ‘the God of our ancestors has chosen you to know his will and to see the Righteous One and to hear words from his mouth. You will be his witness to all people of what you have seen and heard.’” -Acts 22:14-15

1. When witnessing, sharing certain credentials connects us with our audience. (v. 3)
2. Transparency concerning our past actions sets the stage for effective witnessing. (v. 5)
3. When witnessing, it's helpful to share how we come to know Jesus Christ. (vv. 6-13)
4. We are called to share the gospel and our life changing experience
